

Program Review Membership Meeting on 6/24/2025

The June, 2025 Speaker for Red River Desk and Derrick Club was Ms. Laurie McGehee, Executive Director of the FREE Coalition to End Human Trafficking IN Northwest Louisiana. She is a thirty-nine veteran of the Juvenile Justice System, having served the Juvenile Court for Caddo Parish in many different capacities. She was the Chief Probation Officer for fifteen plus years and oversaw all operations for the Probation Department, including Juvenile Drug Court, Family Preservation Court, Mental Health Court, and STAR Court. She retired in March 2024 and now devotes her time and energy to the FREE Coalition, which provides free training on human trafficking awareness and response and provide direct services to high-risk youth and victims of human trafficking in the community and for the STAR Court Program at Caddo Parish Juvenile Court.

Ms. McGehee explained the definition of human trafficking as anyone who is involved in the sex industry through force, fraud, or coercion, including adults. She stated that Caddo Prish is the third highest Parish in the State of Louisiana for reported confirmed cases of human trafficking. Victims can be anyone, any age, any race, any socio-economic background. Victims can also be recruited by other victims or traffickers anywhere. According to data reports from the Louisiana Governor's Office of Human Trafficking Prevention, African American females comprise the highest number of reported victims in our state. Risk factors for someone to be recruited into trafficking include those living in poverty, children who are in foster care, children in the juvenile justice system, children who have ben sexually abused and children who are runaways and absent from school.

Red flags that may indicate someone may be involved in sex trafficking include excessive absences from school or a pattern of truancy, repeated runaway behavior, possession of multiple cell phones, possession of expensive clothing or accessories, tattoos or brandings on the body, possessing excessive cash or cash apps on their phones, someone who is easily triggered or easily angered, someone who is dressed inappropriately, having an older male or female companion, will not make eye contact, indication of lack of sleep or food.

The best way to fight and end human trafficking is to be aware of the risks and red flags and be involved with your children and grandchildren. Know what they are doing on social media, their phones and who their friends are. Ms. McGehee explained that if anyone suspects someone is being trafficked, they should contact local law enforcement and the Department of Children and Family Services if the victim is a minor. Anyone can call the National Human Trafficking Hotline at any time at 888i-373-7888 or text 233733.



Be sure to get these submitted. If you have already submitted your form, thank you. I will send out a reminder as the due date approaches.


