

Program Review Membership Meeting on 8/26/2025



Speaker: Tyler Comeaux Director of Operations Port of Caddo Bossier

The Port of Caddo-Bossier was established in the mid-1980's. However, it did not accept its first shipment until 1995. The Port currently has approximately 5,000 acres, which are divided into various tracts. The Port is governed by a 9-member Board: President, Vice President, Secretary/Treasurer and (6) Commissioners.

In 1968, J. Bennett Johnston helped to create the Red River Waterway project to add five lock & dam complexes which straightened the stream of the Red River. It is now referred to as the J. Bennett Johnston Waterway. The locks and dams are operated by the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers.

Port of Caddo-Bossier Central Louisiana Regional Port Natchitoches Red River Avoyelles

The Port has approximately (20) tenants, some of those being Alpine Silica, Benteler Steel, Calumet Packaging and Oakley Louisiana, just to name a few.

A drone overview was shown of the port and it showed how a modular building was loaded onto a barge. The Port is involved with Union Pacific in a new rail project and the estimated cost is \$15 Million.

As of January 2024 there are approximately 32 ports in the State of Louisiana. State law establishes separate port authorities to govern each of Louisiana's 32 active public ports, with 31 (96.9%) governed by a board of commissioners. State law empowers all 32 active ports to regulate commerce and port traffic within their jurisdictions in the best interest of the state, the port area, and/or the public. Because ports function as individual entities, they determine their own infrastructure projects and development strategies and must coordinate their efforts on their own or through groups like the Ports Association of Louisiana (PAL).


